

ABFDE WORKSHOP

Case Examinations of Medical and Business Records

Date: Saturday, August 16, 2008

Location: Asheville, N.C.

Duration: One (1) day, 8 hrs - 0800 – 1700.

The workshop will encompass commonly encountered business records case problems. The instructors will engage the attendees in discussion about methodology, approach and conclusions. Participants will receive original case materials in advance of workshop attendance, and will be required to examine two (2) case problems and document all physical evidence for the group discussion. In conclusion, a panel of highly experienced examiners will cover techniques of documenting findings; suggested methods of dealing with attorneys, avoidance of biases and other problems frequently encountered in medical/business records examinations.

Five (5) original case problems will be sent in June to each attendee with a short scenario. The examiners can call designated instructors for additional information, if needed to complete the assignment. Only two (2) of the case problems will be the responsibility of the individual attendees.

Lunch and breaks will be included in the cost of attendance.
