

## How to “fix” the Firefox browser

The menu system used by the ASQDE website may not work unless you download a free Firefox add-on program. It doesn't take long to make this change. The add-on program works for us and we don't know of any problems associated with making this modification. Of course, it is not our software, and we cannot be responsible for how the add-on may affect your software or computer. If you choose to not to make the modification, the ASQDE website works fine with the Microsoft Internet Explorer browser.

- 1) Check the Tools menu for an "IE Tabs Options" selection. If present, it will be in the drop down menu. You should proceed to step 8. If not, proceed to step 2.
- 2) In the Tools Menu, click on Add-ons (early versions may use the term Extensions).
- 3) When the Add-ons selection is clicked, a window opens up displaying extensions that have been downloaded (may be blank). In the lower right corner, you should click on “Get Extensions”.
- 4) A page entitled “Firefox Add-ons: Browse Extensions by Category” will open. There is a search window on the page. Enter “IE Tab” in the search window.
- 5) After the search, a page with an “IE Tab” link should appear. Click on the link.
- 6) Click on “Install Now” and then click “Install Now” again.
- 7) Click on “Restart Firefox”. If asked, click on “Close Tabs”.
- 8) Once Firefox restarts, go the ASQDE page at [www.asqde.org](http://www.asqde.org).
- 9) Go to the Tools Menu. A selection entitled “IE Tab Options” should have been added to the menu. Click it.
- 10) In the URL window, the entry “<http://www.asqde.org/>” should be present.
- 11) Click on “Add” and then click “OK”.
- 12) Reload the ASQDE page.
- 13) The ASQDE site's menu system should now work in Firefox.
